Rutgers Athletic Parking Garage



The RWJ Barnabas Health Athletic Performance Center at Rutgers University has been created as a partnership between Rutgers & RWJBarnabas Health to develop a comprehensive sports medicine program to serve Rutgers Athletes, Students & Communities throughout New Jersey.

Through this partnership, RWJBarnabas Health will become the exclusive health care provider for Rutgers Athletics, while creating a best-in-class sports medicine program that can be expanded across the state.

Precast Services, Inc. just completed erection of the six (6) level Athletic Performance Centers Parking Deck and is now starting the erection of architectural panels on the adjacent RJBarnabas Health Athletic Performance Center, which also will be the headquarters for a world-class sports medicine program.

RWJBarnabas Health will develop and manage the program, which will provide Rutgers' 625 NCAA Division I Intercollegiate Athletes with an extensive array of health care services and pursue advances in sports medicine.



The RWJBarnabas Health Sports Medicine Program will be comprised of athletic trainers, physical therapists, sports medicine physicians, orthopedic surgeons, sports psychologists, psychiatrists and other behavioral health specialists, sports performance specialists and nutritional experts.

The sports medicine program will aim to advance academic opportunities in sports-medicine fields. Affiliated physicians and practitioners will be able to hone sports medicine skills in a Big Ten practice setting, whether in the renovated Hale Center, RWJBarnabas Health Athletic Performance Center or on the sidelines at athletics practices and games.

The building will provide state-of-the-art practice facilities, training areas, locker room and office space for men's and women's basketball, wrestling and gymnastics. A café serving healthy meals to student-athletes, as well as a merchandise store open to the general public, will also be included in the facility, which rises via the "R Big Ten Build" campaign to raise \$100 million for new or upgraded facilities.

Washington Twp. PG - Turnersville, NJ



Precast Services, Inc. recently began work on our portion of Jefferson Washington Township Hospital's \$220-million expansion at the campus medical facility, located in Turnersville, New Jersey.

Jefferson Health commissioned CallisonRTKL to provide design services for an overall campus redevelopment as part of a broader effort to redefine the medical facility and image. Construction for this two-phase redevelopment commenced in June 2018, beginning with an eight-story parking garage. The phase one parking garage will have 820 spaces, consolidating campus parking into one convenient location.

The buildout of the parking garage began by constructing a temporary lot while the underground basin is in development. Following completion, phase two will include a new tower yielding 60 critical care and acute care patient rooms.

Construction for the bed tower will begin in 2019 and is expected to be completed by 2021.

New Brunswick Performing Arts

The New Brunswick Performing Arts

Center is a \$171.8 million, 450,000-square-foot redevelopment project that includes two world class theatres, 207 apartments, 30,000 square feet of office space, in addition to the parking garage. This successful public-private partnership project is the centerpiece of a redevelopment initiative that will transform New Brunswick's Downtown Cultural Arts District.

The center's larger theater space includes a 465-seat lyric proscenium theater, designed to accommodate musical theater, dance, opera and dramatic theater, with an 86-foot stage and an orchestra pit. It also will include a tower for suspended stage scenery and equipment and a trap system below the stage used for scenery effects. The smaller theater will seat 253 people and is designed for theatrical performances, smaller dance performances and lectures, as well as community and musical events. Three rehearsal spaces that replicate the stage spaces will free the main venues for more scheduled performances.

The performing arts center is expected to draw an additional 80,000 arts patrons to the city's cultural center, which already brings in 400,000 people a year.
